TG WORLD AND PARTNERS SPUD SAK RIVER #1A EXPLORATION WELL ON ALASKA NORTH SLOPE

CALGARY, ALBERTA – TG World Energy Corp. (TSX-V: TGE) (“TG World” or the “Company”) is pleased to announce that Nabors 16E rig spudded the Sak River #1a exploration well on the Alaska Central North Slope on January 26, 2010. The well is being drilled from an onshore ice pad to an offshore bottom hole location. The suspended Sak River #1 well has been re-entered and a new hole will be drilled after the cement plug at the base of the surface casing set to 4,225 feet has been drilled-out. The well is expected to reach total depth of approximately 12,500 feet in February. Brooks Range Petroleum Corporation (“BRPC”), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Alaska Venture Capital Group, is operator of the well and Ramshorn Investments Inc. is the other joint venture (“JV”) partner.

The Sak River #1a well will test a Kuparuk formation exploration prospect identified by proprietary 3-D seismic data. The prospect is located within the JV’s Beechey Point Unit (“Unit”), which includes the undeveloped North Shore #1 and Pete’s Wicked oil discoveries. A Sak River #1a discovery would likely be developed in conjunction with the existing oil discoveries. TG World will pay 45.7% of the well costs to participate for its 35% working interest in the Unit.

Corporate Profile

TG World is a Calgary-based, junior international oil and gas exploration company currently focused on Alaska and Niger.

TG World Energy Inc. (a wholly owned subsidiary of TG World) is partnered with operator Brooks Range Petroleum Corp., Alaska Venture Capital Group, Brooks Range Development Corp. and Ramshorn Investments Inc. in a joint venture that is pursuing oil and gas opportunities on the Central North Slope of Alaska. The joint venture has oil and gas activities in four geographical areas in Alaska: Slugger/South Thomson, Tofkat, North Tarn and the Beechey Point Unit, which borders the Prudhoe Bay oil development area. The joint venture intends to drill wells in the Beechey Point Unit this winter drilling season.

TG World Petroleum Limited (a wholly-owned subsidiary of TG World) is partnered with operator CNPCIT, a unit of the China National Petroleum Company, in the Ténéré Block oil and gas concession in the Republic of Niger, Africa. The Company has a 20% carried interest in the Ténéré Block, which contains the northern half of the Termit - Ténéré Rift, a large rift valley basin in the country. The southern half of this rift is located in the adjacent Agadem Block, where the Chinese National Petroleum Company holds several oil and gas discoveries. A security warning has recently been lifted in the Ténéré Block area and the operator is considering alternatives for potential drilling.
